The successful candidate will be required to work both as a Community Health Nurse (0.6 FTE) and as a fee-based community educator (up to 0.4 EFT).

- current registration as a Registered Nurse with the Australian Health Practitioner Regulation Agency
- demonstrated experience of 3 years or more working in a primary care/ community setting or in community programs
